Finale: "We are Music"

We Are Music

Music is more than a pass-time or a hobby; it is more than an art. Music is embedded within the foundational core of mankind. I do not believe there has ever been a culture on the earth that did not create and embrace music of some sort. There is a clear reason for this: we are musical beings. The resonance of music physiologically affects us. Our bodies themselves are resonant. Being in the direct presence of a musical performance causes noticeable physical reaction. It is one of the reasons live performances are so much more powerful to the listener. Of course there is also a strong emotional response as previous was discussed in a post. Music experienced in a purely physical manner can be powerful. I would say that this is a common experience for casual listeners of popular

People enjoy and even need music in their lives because of the physiological reaction that they have with it. However, when music reacts with us on an emotional level our embrace of it and need for it strengthens. Many experience a stratum even beyond this when music takes on a spiritual dimension. At this point, we are living a core element of our being that is simultaneously felt physically, emotionally, and spiritually. The intensity this produces internally can not be overstated. There are certainly powerful reasons music becomes such an important part of a music student's life. It is a discipline that connects to their core. It connects to their feelings. It gives them creative power. It allows them to share intimately without having to talk or "open up" in a traditional manner. It is a challenge. It is fun. And these are also the reasons we teach music.
